authorizes another two persons then the persons authorized by the President shall prevail. Sub Clause (5) of Clause 4 provides that the President or the Secretary General shall prepare the list of authorized representatives of the Member States and the 23 people who are the representative in the Suit were not authorized by the President. This isapparent from the record.

- In this scenario following situations are possible
 - a. Counting of Official group shall be held
 - b. Counting of Official Group shall not be held
 - c. Counting of the representatives of the plaintiff shall be held
 - d. Counting of the representatives of the plaintiff shall not be held.
 - e. No Counting will at all take place of either of the groups.
 - f. Counting of both the groups will be held.

Stuations no. b and e in so far as Official Group is concerned cannot be accepted because there is no Court Injunction.

As to Counting of the representative of the plaintiff is concerned there is a direction of the Hon'ble High Court to keep the votes after casting in a sealed cover. Opening the sealed Cover will amount to
