

violation of secrecy. There is another legal difficulty .Under the Sports Code each state shall be represented by two votes as authorized by the President. In respect of the Official List some states like Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, Orissa , Gujarat are represented by two representatives as were authorized by the President. In the list of the 23 persons representing the Plaintiffs of the suit we find again Kerala , Uttar Pradesh, Orissa , Gujarat etc is being represented by another set of two representatives . The result of counting of both the voting group will be that some states will be having 4votes each which is thoroughly illegal in terms of the guidelines / bye laws of the AICF . If we open both the boxes we will be unable to decide which of the two representatives of these states should be recognized as valid votes and will be not recognized as not valid votes.

11. In such a scenario I have decided that since there is no injunction against counting of votes of the Official Group of 53 people let there be Counting of those votes of only leaving the question of counting of votes of the representatives of the Plaintiff ^{to be} is adjudicated by the Hon'ble Court as the matter is sub judice and the box containing votes of the representatives of the 23 voters in a sealed cover duly signed by the polling agent and the R.O on the Box is preserved as has been directed by the Hon'ble Court.
